REACH SUBSTANCE STATEMENT

Xmultiple Connector Series, REACH Compliant Requirements

Xmultiple have produced the following statement as a guide to its distributors/Customers on the **R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorization and **R**estriction of **C**hemical substances (REACH).

The REACH document states that it is the responsibility of the importer to comply with REACH. All EU countries have a responsibility to comply.

The REACH document has two important parts concerning our connectors, Registration and Notification.

Registration

We have considered the document and do not believe that the importers of our connectors have a responsibility to register any substance with ECHA. The criteria to register are that the product is a substance or Article. The connectors are clearly an article and do not release any substances as part of their normal working function.

Notification

ECHA have officially released the list of substances that must be notified to them if they are in our connectors.

Xmultiple has been undertaking the task of conducting testing with a third party company to do the chemical analysis's to check if any of these substances are in our connectors.

The outcome of all these substances test has not been completed, however, our initial test show that these chemicals are not in our connectors.
